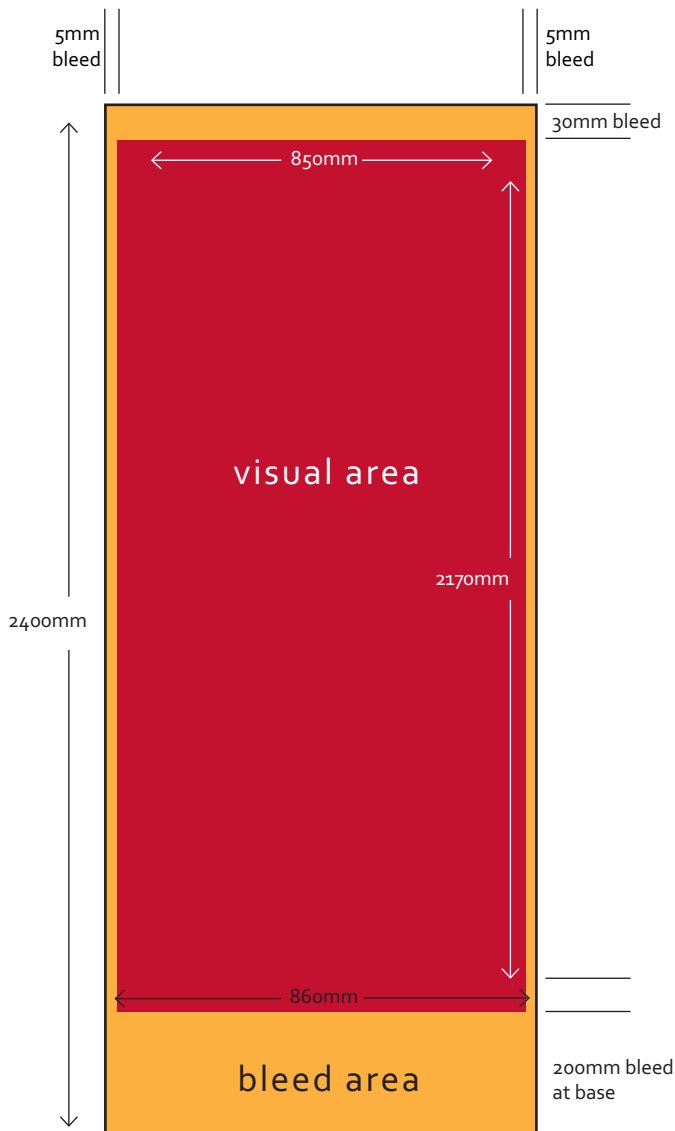

BannerBug Artwork Requirements

- All text and logos must appear inside the 'visual area'. The 'bleed area' will not be visible when banner is erect, however to ensure a professional finish, any background colours or graphics must extend to the bleed areas.
- We recommend setting up your artwork to 25% of actual size, however artwork may be set up as little as 10% of actual size if need be. Resolution must be at least 75dpi at final print size.

| 1000 BannerBug | 1000 x 2170 |
| Giant BannerBug | 1000 x 2850 |
| 1200 BannerBug | 1200 x 2170 |
| 1500 BannerBug | 1500 x 2170 |
| 1800 BannerBug | 1800 x 2170 |

Bleed area for all BannerBugs is 30mm at top, 200mm at base, 5mm at left and right sides.



BASIC REQUIREMENTS for large format digital printing

- 1 Before setting up artwork please confirm with us the exact dimensions of your graphic.
 - 2 As a general rule, artwork should be set up at 25% of actual size.
 - 3 Be sure to include relevant bleed (see individual banner specifications for bleed requirements) and ensure any background colours or graphics extend to these areas.
 - 4 Resolution must be at least 75dpi at final print size.
 - 5 Ensure all illustrator text is converted to outlines.
 - 6 If supplying Indesign files, they should be packaged to include all fonts, images etc.
 - 7 Please supply us with a colour proof of your final artwork and include clear written instructions.
 - 8 All of our printing is produced in CMYK. Whilst every effort is made to ensure accurate colour matching we cannot guarantee it. Please note any PMS numbers if colour matching is required. If you are concerned about colour accuracy, we recommend you request a proof to check colours prior to printing.
 - 9 We accept most file types, however for best results artwork should be set up in either Adobe Indesign or Adobe Illustrator. Please be aware that Artwork set up in Photoshop will not produce clear, crisp text.
